- 4. Will it be ok for our computers to have access to your network for remote monitoring? Monitoring via a secure connection will be acceptable. Successful contractor will have to work with MCC IT to get this setup
- 5. Is remote power management required to shut off displays? Or would a standby mode be acceptable? Standby power will be acceptable as long as it doesn't have a negative effect on the LED life
- 6. Would a perforated bezel be acceptable for displays? No

- 7. Is removing the glass mullion part of our scope? Yes, removal of the glass is part of the scope
- 8. Who is responsible for network connectivity? (In Room "A") Connectivity to each location is the responsibility of the proposer
