MCC harvested 114 lbs of honey in FY 19 from the bees on our rooftop.



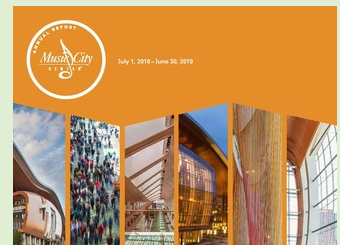
